

RESOLUTION NO. 6558

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING FIRE AND LIFE SAFETY SERVICE FEES AND REPEALING RESOLUTION NO. 2939 AND SECTION III.A-B OF RESOLUTION NO. 6548.

WHEREAS, the City Council reviews and authorizes service fees; and

WHEREAS, the Albany City Council established a fee schedule for Fire Department fireworks and fixed hazardous materials storage tank permits (Resolution No. 2939); and

WHEREAS the Fire Department has identified the need to adjust the fireworks and fixed hazardous materials storage tank permit fees and assess a new Fire Code compliance re-inspection fee; and

WHEREAS, the Albany City Council previously determined that revenues from charges for Private Fire Protection are most appropriately used by the Fire Department for tasks such as regular Fire Code compliance inspection (Resolution No. 6411); and

WHEREAS, Private Fire Protection charges should be removed from current and future water rate resolutions (Resolution No. 6548) concurrent with the Fire Department's effort to consolidate all Department fees into one resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED the City Council of Albany, Oregon, authorizes the fees described in Exhibit A to be established effective January 1, 2017, for services provided by the Fire Department; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 2939 is hereby repealed; and



Inside City Limits - Applicable to standpipes, connections for automatic sprinkler systems, and fire hydrant service for private fire protection located within city limits.

Outside City Limits - Applicable to standpipes, connections for automatic sprinkler systems, and fire hydrant service for private fire protection located within city limits.

Monthly rates as listed for Inside City Limits with a 10 percent surcharge on said rates for service outside the city limits.

Special Conditions for All Fire Protection Services - Water taken under this classification is to be used only to extinguish fires and for flushing necessary to maintain fire protection equipment. In case of surreptitious or improper use of water, the consumption may be estimated and the water used shall be billed at regular meter rates.
